Staff are finalising their performance plans to achieve their mid-cycle review status.



The 2017 Parent Opinion Survey will be conducted state-wide in a two-week period from late July to early August. The overall objective of this survey is to collect data about parent opinion across the state, and for individual schools to use the data to inform school improvement. The survey remains the same as last year providing parents with the opportunity to 'have a say'. A random list of families is generated by the Department of Education and Training (DET) and submitted to the school and we then distribute and collect the surveys. After many months in the making, homework club begins at 3.30pm this Friday. All children who attend homework club will be given fifteen minutes after school to eat a snack. Homework Club will begin promptly at 3.30pm in Mrs. Perry's classroom, and in the breakout space if there are enough students.

As the club will be run on a completely voluntary basis, if there are any parents or secondary school students in our community who would like to assist us with homework club please contact the school.

Homework Club will finish promptly at 4.30pm so please be on time to collect your children.

This is an opportunity to access extra tuition for your children, so we hope as many families as possible will make use of this support.

We're conducting a survey to find out what you think of our school.

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The Parent Opinion Survey is completed annually by the Department of Education and Training and is conducted amongst a sample of randomly selected parents at every school in Victoria. This year, about 30 per cent of parents will be invited to participate. All responses to the survey are anonymous.

The survey helps our school gain an understanding of how you view our school climate, student engagement, and relationships. Our school will use the results to inform school planning and improvement strategies.

The survey will be conducted online by ORIMA Research Pty Ltd and only takes 15 minutes to complete. It can be accessed from Monday 7th August to Sunday 27th August.

The survey is available in English, Arabic, Vietnamese, Mandarin, Chin (Hakha) and Hindi.

Results will be sent back to our school at the end of September.

Before and after school care

- Enrolments are now available for Before and After School Care for Lightning Reef PS Families
- The program will be delivered from Lightning Reef ELC (next door to the school)
- Families can enrol online www.bendigo.ymca.org.au click on After School Care link then Register and Enrol on left hand side. Read the information regarding how to enrol then click on link for either Lightning Reef After School Care or Before School care
- Families wishing to enrol in both can click on either link and tick boxes for both before and after school care at the top of the form.
- Families requiring assistance to enrol can talk to either Primary School or YMCA Children's Services Admin Staff
- Enrolments must be complete and formalised by CCMS before bookings can be made
- All general information regarding YMCA Outside School Hours is available in the OSHC Family Handbook on the website

Before School Care 7am-8.30am \$15 Children to be signed in at Lightning Reef ELC, they will move to Lightning Reef Breakfast Program at 8.30am

After School Care 3.15pm-6pm \$25 Children to be collected from Lightning Reef ELC

These fees are before any CCB or CCR is applied. The average family will pay \$5.50 BSC and \$8.15 ASC after CCB and CCR is applied.

All bookings are to be made through Children's Services admin, and must be paid for at the time of booking, to secure your place. Payment can be paid with cash or EFTPOS.

We look forward to this opportunity to further develop our partnership with the school and to provide more flexible care arrangements for the Lightning Reef families.


Can you please check that your child has the following items ready for learning and that they are in a good working condition – eg – not broken....etc and replace these ASAP.


If your child DOES NOT need these, then there is no need to replace them.
