PLACE VALUE AND NUMBER 4/5 HASTY/TONZING

Over the past three weeks during Numeracy lessons we have been exploring 2, 3, 4 and 5 digit numbers. Maths activities in our classroom have focused on place value, rounding and using number lines.

This week we made a large 0 - 100 number line from string. Students had to determine where to peg their number on the number line and give reasons as to why they put it there. They also had to work out where the half way point was on number lines that started and ended at different points. For example, what number would be marked at halfway on a number line starting at 50 and ending at 150? The children have enjoyed these 'hands on' activities and have engaged in great discussions about how to solve these maths problems in different ways.
