
WARM WEATHER & SNAKES: DISCUSS WITH YOUR CHILD

Zamael "I loved decorating my cup because it was satisfying"


Ner Dah "I also liked decorating the clay, because we got to add any materials that we liked and were allowed to be very creative and individual".
