Join Raven on the basketball court on Friday 13th March @ 2:30 pm to see his lovely locks being shaved.

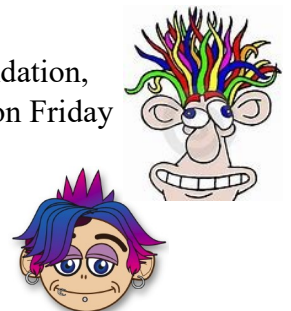
To help Raven with his fundraising we will be having a "Crazy Hair Day" so come along with your craziest hairdo.

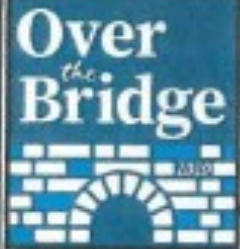
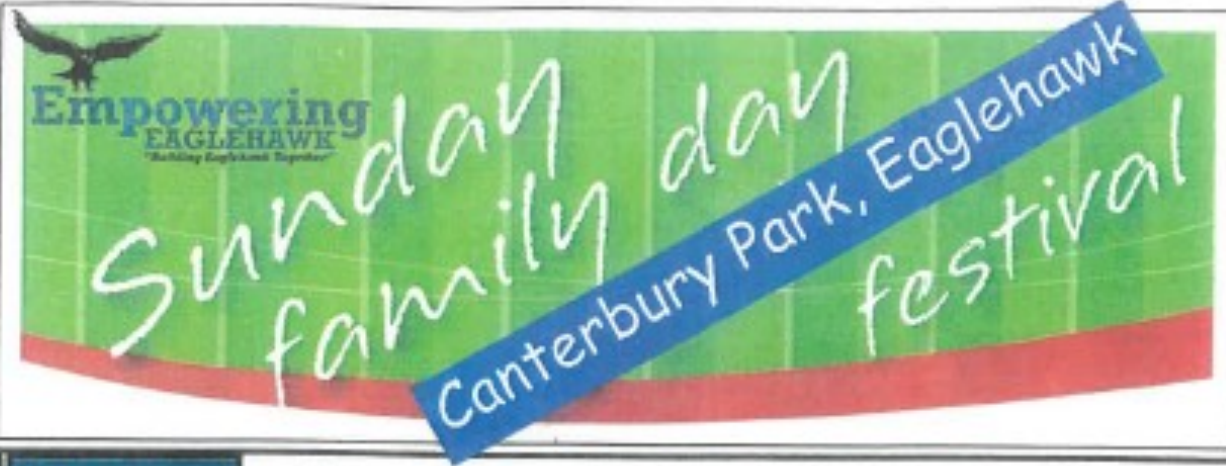
