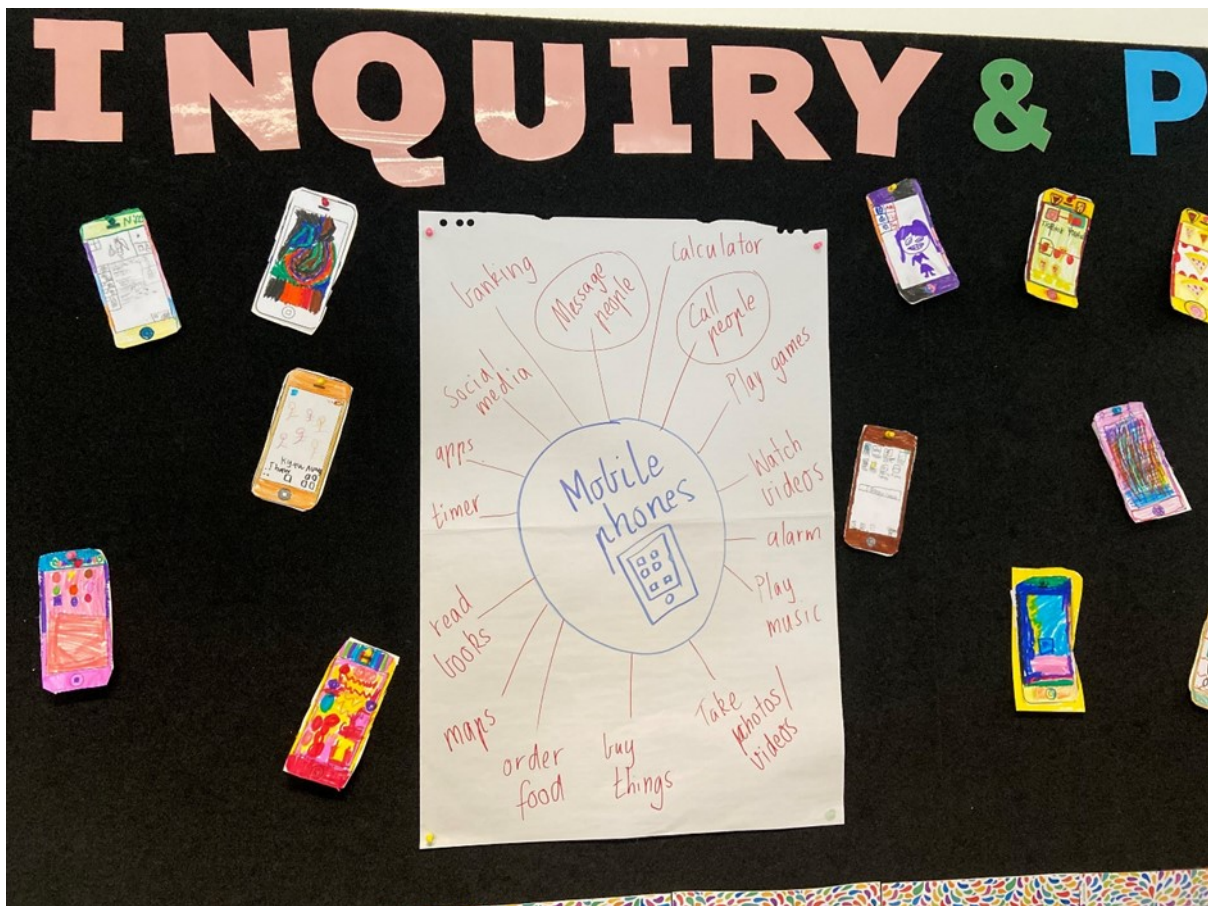


Room 4 News

Our school Fun Run will take place on the last day of Term, 27th March, from 12-1.30. Students are encouraged to wear their house colours.

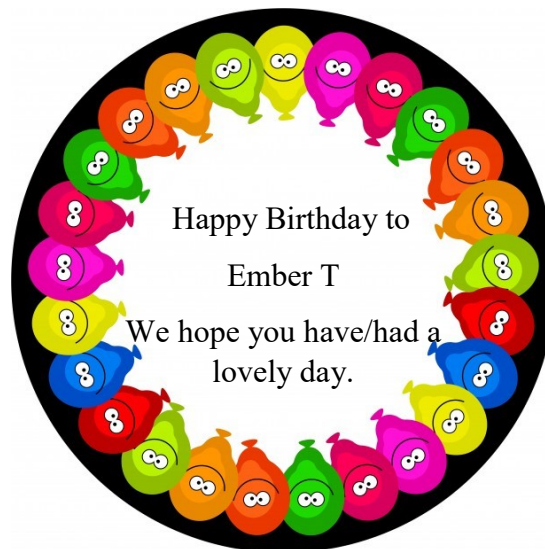
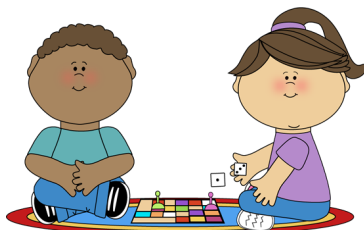
