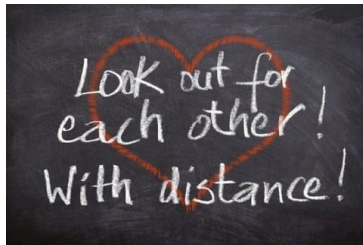


1. A copy of the birth certificate (we can make copies of originals if necessary) and
2. A school entry immunisation certificate obtained from The Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR). Phone 1800653809 or apply online to obtain a copy.

Enrolment forms are now available for collection from the office.

If you know anyone moving into our area, has a child attending your child's pre-school or who **has a Prep child for next year and is considering options, talk to them about our school.**

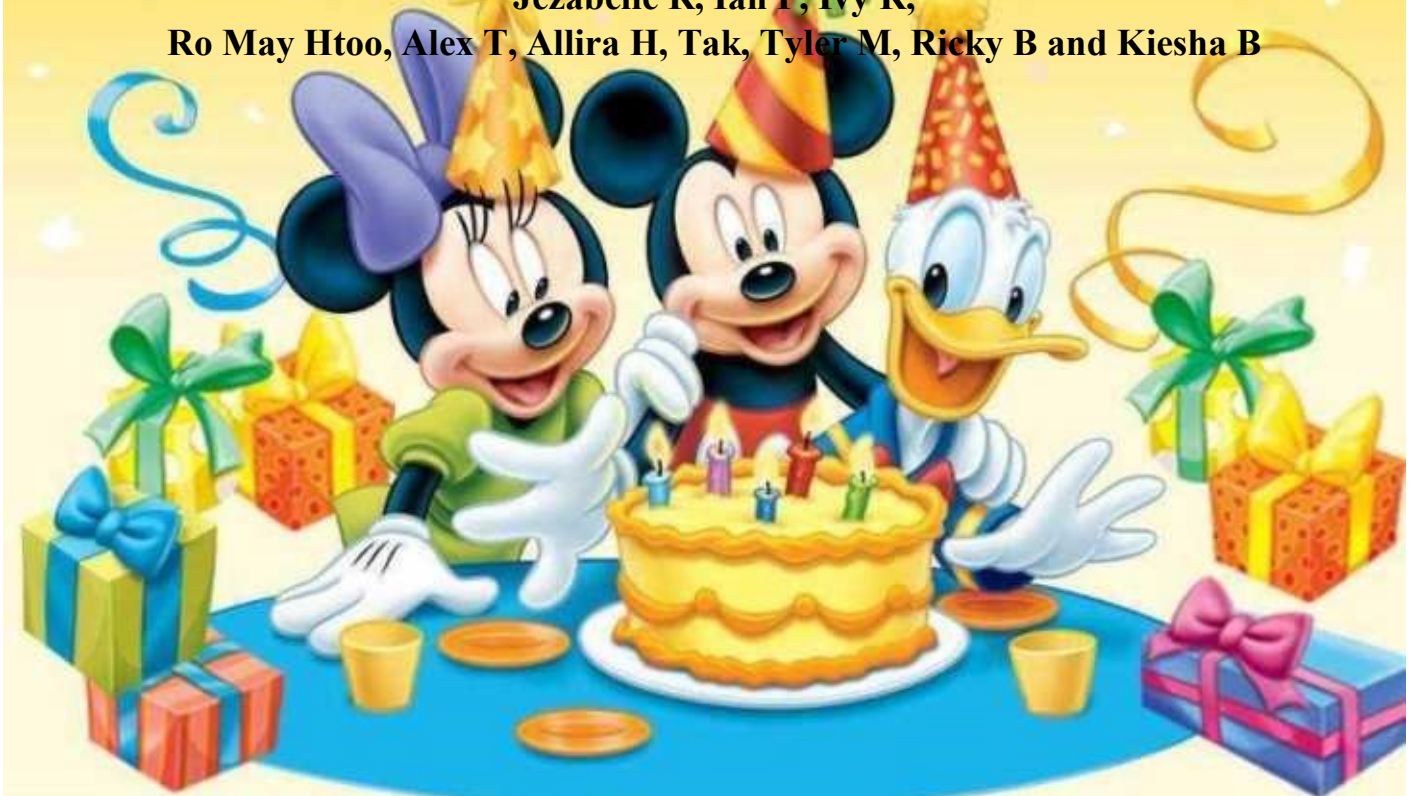

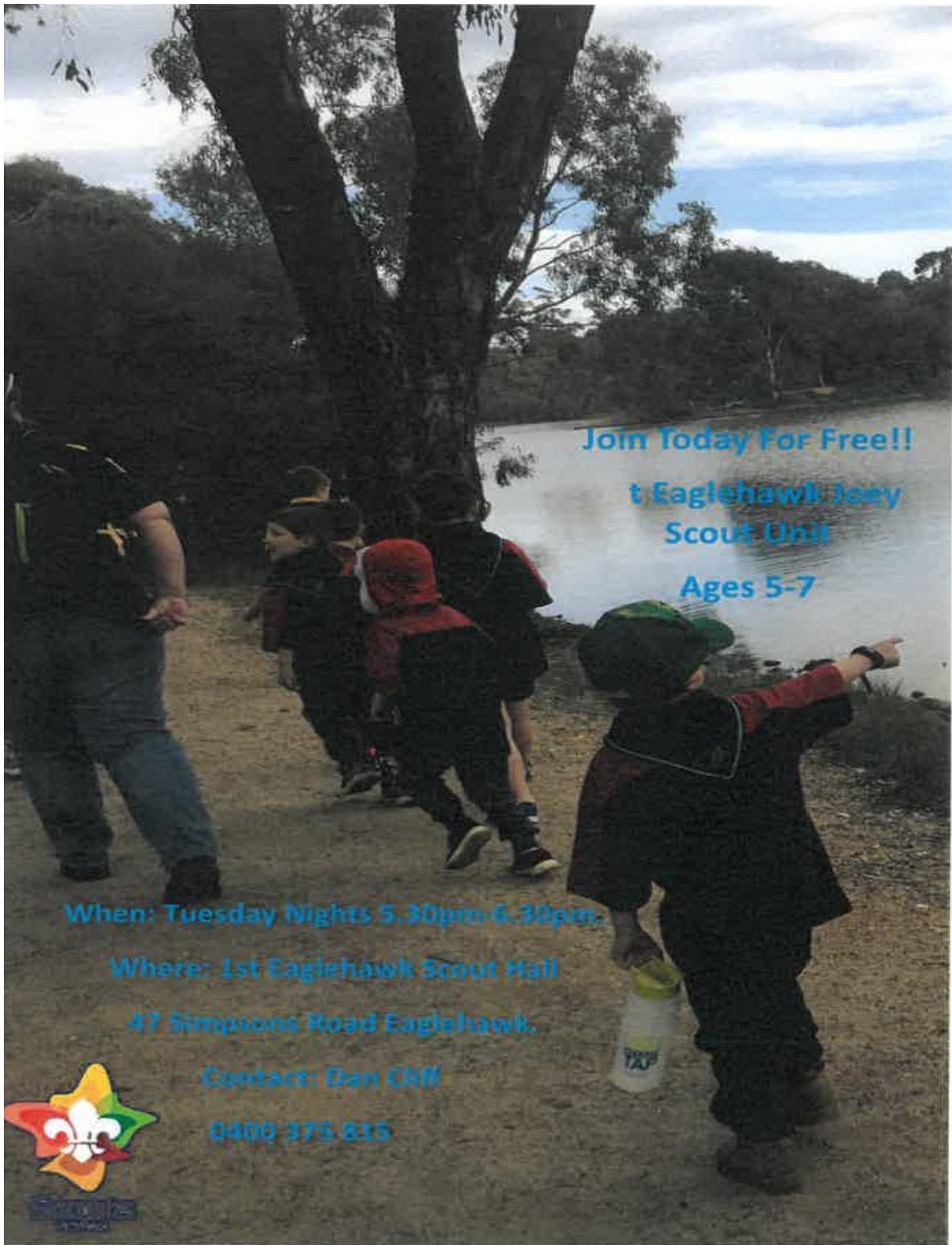
