IS YOUR CHILD'S PLAN UPDATED?



Parents / Carers, please note - For those students with Asthma, please ensure the school has a labelled Ventolin and spacer (if required) provided. We are unable to supply a re-usable spacer for students at school. The school has purchased disposable spacers. Check with the office to determine if your child's plan is current or not. We have the most up to date forms available in the office of which can be emailed to you should you require one.

SCHOOL CARPARK

Please take care when driving in to the school carpark. We are experiencing many cars entering and exiting the carpark incorrectly. This is placing the students, staff and yourselves at risk. The double lines on the roadway mean you need to go to the traffic lights and complete your turn, ensuring you enter the carpark from the correct way. The double lines also mean, you cannot turn right from the carpark. Always turn LEFT when exiting the carpark.

FOUNDATION (PREP) ENROLMENTS 2021

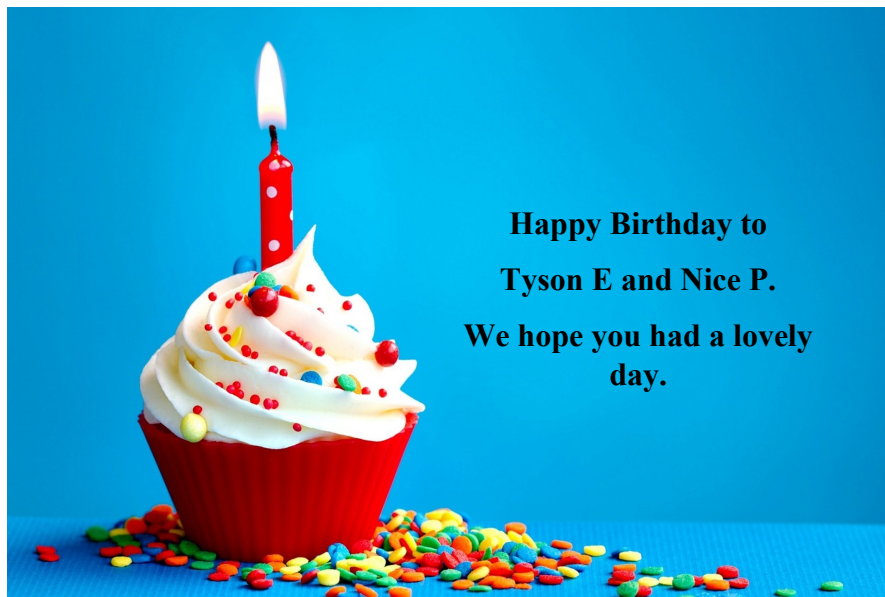

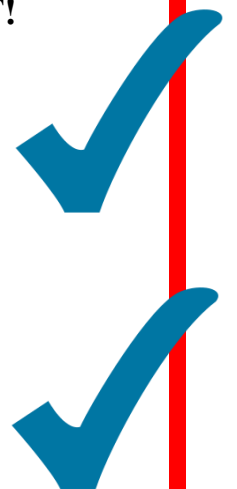

DRAMA AND MUSIC



Grades P/1/2 have been very enthusiastic about learning Drama this term. We have worked on using our bodies and faces to express emotions, as well as voice projection. The students have enjoyed using the puppets to create interesting characters. They introduced their puppets to one another and had some very interesting conversations!

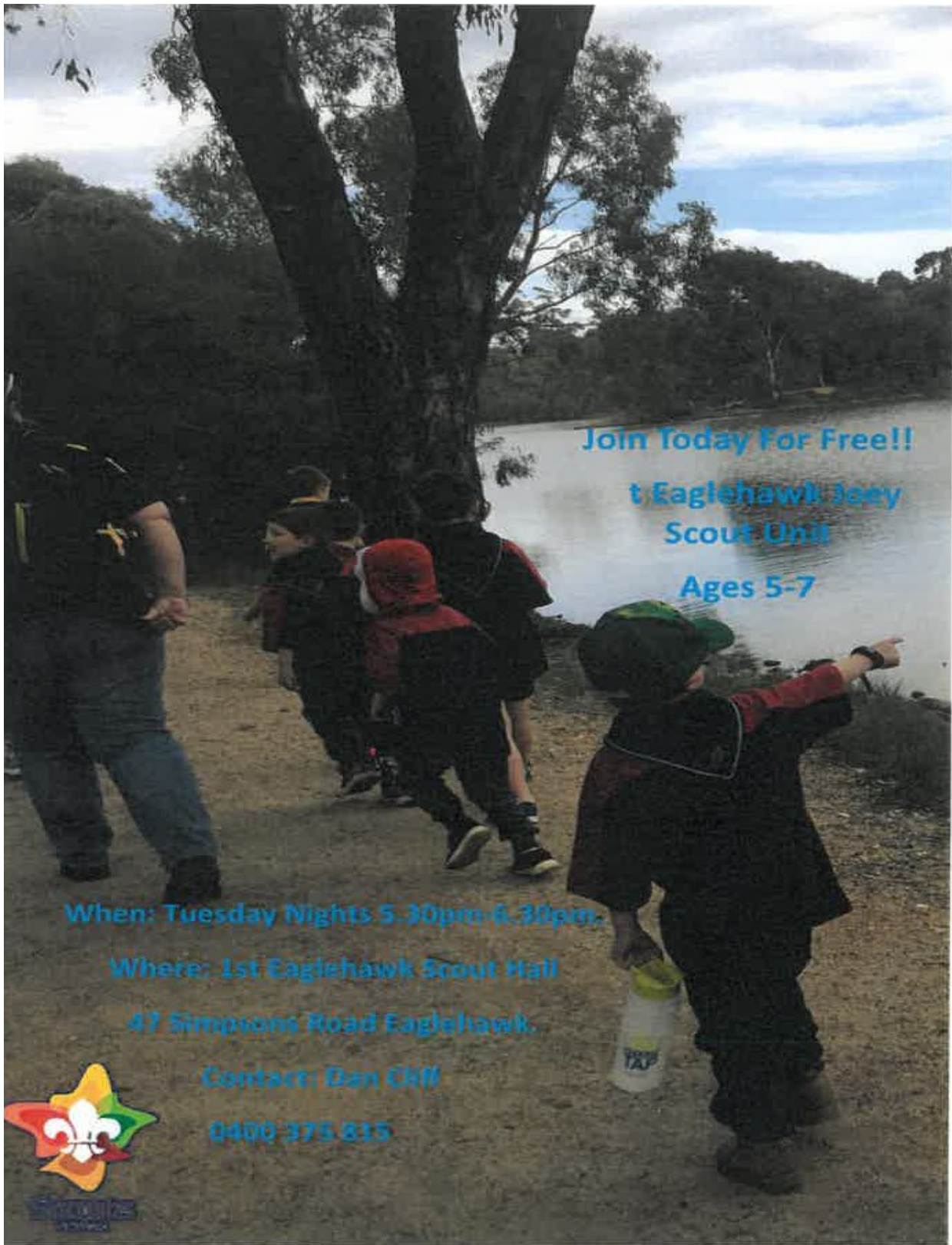
