Book Week 2020

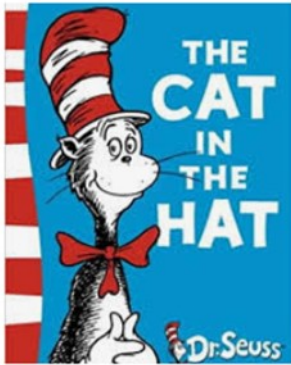
We will be celebrating Book Week on **Wednesday 21st October**.

Each classroom will have the opportunity to read Australian books that have been shortlisted for the 2020 CBCA Book of the year and complete a fun activity with their classroom teachers.

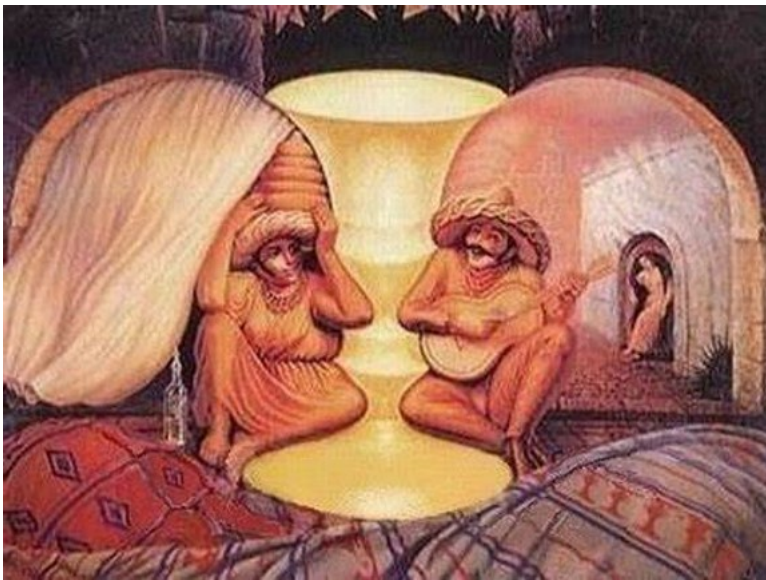
